Goal 1 Operational Excellence

 - McKinney to Munich (M2M)-We partnered with Hofbrau to host a sweepstakes to win a trip to Munich's Oktoberfest in 2020. It started Aug. 1 and ended Sept. 29. Each person could gain up to 36 entries using the Rafflecopter app. Many of these people were already in our mailing list for our e-newsletter but we did gain quite a few new subscribers and had great visibility for Visit McKinney at our Oktoberfest tent. It also drove lots of traffic to our website and social media. Our winner was Jack Keller; we'll be awarding him the prize this week. Results are:
 - 47,298 M2M entries
 - 940 people on the clicker over the past three days
 - 4,955 visits during contest time (Aug. 1- Sept. 29) on our website contest page
 - 522 new Facebook followers
 - 627 new Instagram followers
 - 2,189 new email subscribers
 - We were able to secure two last-minute remnant rate ads last week that include special online coverage in addition to print:
 - Sports Destination Marketing Magazine/website— a 1/3 page ad promoting The Courts as a tournament destination in their Nov.-Dec., the issue that features tennis and pickleball.
 - Horizons Travel We got a full page (half ad/half editorial content with photo) in Horizon Travel's insert
 in the Texas/Southwest December issue of The Wall Street Journal. This placement comes with a brief
 video spot on the ABC screen in Times Square over seven days in November.
 - Staff attended the Visit DFW Texas Travel IdeaFest in Arlington. The day-long workshop brought together tourism brand marketers and social media influencers to learn about how best to work together. This allowed staff to connect with several influencers/bloggers interested in coming to McKinney. Staff is working with them to schedule times to host them here.
 - Free Publicity: The three Christmas gift ideas from McKinney that were submitted to *County Line Magazine* were all published in the November/December issue as was a photo sent for one of the gift ideas (food tour). The submission amounted to roughly 2/3 of a page, or \$1610.40 in free media value and \$4831.20 in PR print value. We are awaiting numbers from the publisher on digital value, where they used a second photo with the submissions.
