Chair Woodard continued the meeting with the Regular Agenda Items and Public Hearings on the Agenda.

26-0021SP Conduct a Public Hearing to Consider/Discuss/Act on a Design Exception to a Site Plan for a Proposed Warehouse (McKinney Couch Drive Industrial), Located Approximately 105 ft. North of Recovery Way and on the East side of Couch Dr.

Destinee Reynolds, Planner I for the City of McKinney, presented the item and informed the Commission that the item had been withdrawn by the applicant. Chair Woodard opened the public hearing and called for comments. There were none. On a motion by Vice-Chair Buettner, seconded by Commission Member Conrad, The Commission unanimously voted to close the public hearing and table the item indefinitely with a vote of 7-0-0.

26-0027Z Conduct a Public Hearing to Consider/Discuss/Act on a Request to Rezone the Subject Property from "BN" - Neighborhood Business to "TR1.8" - Townhome Residential District, Located at 1001 North Tennessee Street.

Kyara Robinson, Planner I for the City of McKinney, presented the item. The Commission asked questions that were addressed by Staff. Casey Gregory, Applicant, 2000 N McDonald St, McKinney, TX, explained the request and answered questions. Chair Woodard opened the public hearing and called for comments. There were none. On a motion by Commission Member Craig, seconded by Commission Member Lebo, the Commission unanimously voted to close the public hearing and approve the item with a vote of 7-0-0.

Kaitlin Sheffield, Chief Planner with the City of McKinney, presented the item. The Commission asked questions that were addressed by Staff. Bob Roeder, Applicant, 1700 Redbud Blvd, McKinney, TX, explained the request and answered questions. Chair Woodard opened the public hearing and called for comments. There were none. On a motion by Commission Member Conrad, seconded by Alternate Commission Member Kacem, the Commission unanimously voted to close the public hearing and approve the item with a vote of 6-0-0. Commission Member Craig returned to the meeting.

Chair Woodard called for Commission and Staff Comments.
