

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Historic Long Term Planning Initiatives

- City has created 2 plans with a 10-year horizon
 - -General Obligation Debt Service Plan
 - -General Fund Plan
- General Obligation Debt Service Plan
 - Outlines total debt capacity
 - Generally maintains I&S rate

Bond Committee Reports to Council

- Bond Committee Gives Presentation of Recommendations to Council
- Council Discussion Regarding Recommendations
 - –City Council Sets Final Slate of Projects
- Council Directs Staff to Prepare for Calling of Bond Election

Council Calls for Bond Election

- At Council's Direction, Staff Confers with Bond Counsel on Bond Proposition Language
- Structure of Election Ballot Propositions Developed by Bond Counsel
- Call for Bond Election Must Occur 60-Days Prior to Election
