

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-06-___

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS TO MODIFY THE REDUCED SPEED SCHOOL ZONE AND CROSSWALK LOCATIONS DUE TO THE NEW ATTENDANCE BOUNDARIES WITHIN THE MCKINNEY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT; AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THE CAPTION OF THE ORDINANCE, EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF AND A PENALTY CLAUSE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby repeals Section 62-251 Section 62-252, Section 62-253, Section 62-279, Section 62-280, Section 62-281, Section 62-300 Section 62-301 and Section 62-302 of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends Section 62-307 by adding the following subsection of the Code of Ordinances to read as follows:

Sec 62-307. Bennett Elementary School – Zone designated.

(3) On Cotton Ridge Road beginning at a point 300 feet south of Coronado Drive and extending northward along Cotton Ridge Road to a point 270 feet north of Cornado Drive.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends Section 62-307 by adding the following subsection of the Code of Ordinances to read as follows:

Sec 62-309. Same – Crosswalks.

(3) At the intersection of Cotton Ridge Road and Coronado Drive.

Section 4. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends Section 62-304 by adding the following subsection of the Code of Ordinances to read as follows:

Sec 62-304. Vega Elementary School – Zone designated.

(3) On Eastbound Wilmeth Road beginning at a point 265 feet west of Timber Ridge Trail and extending eastward along Wilmeth Road to a point 100 feet east of Timber Ridge Trail.

(4) On Westbound Wilmeth Road beginning at a point 275 feet east of Timber Ridge Trail and extending westward along Wilmeth Road to a point 100 feet west of Timber Ridge Trail.

Section 5. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends Section 62-306 by adding the following subsection of the Code of Ordinances to read as follows:

Sec 62-306. Same – Crosswalks.

(2) At the intersection of Wilmeth Road and Timber Ridge Trail.

Section 6. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends Section 62-238 by adding the following subsection of the Code of Ordinances to read as follows:

Sec 62-238. Evans Middle School – Zone designated.

(3) On Hillsdale Drive beginning at Eldorado Parkway and extending northward along Hillsdale Drive to a point 395 feet south of Bryce Canyon Drive.

(4) On Berkshire Road beginning at a point 300 feet west of Waterbrook Drive and extending eastward along Berkshire Road to a point 200 feet east of Waterbrook Drive.

Section 7. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends the Code of Ordinances by adding a section in Chapter 62, Article V, to be numbered Section 62-239.1, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-239.1 Same – Crosswalks.

The crosswalks shall be established at Evans Middle School as follows:

(1) At the intersection of Berkshire Road at Waterbrook Drive.

Section 8. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends the Code of Ordinances by adding a section in Chapter 62, Article V, to be numbered Section 62-342.2, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-342.2 Same – Crosswalks.

The crosswalks shall be established at McClure Elementary School as follows:

(1) At the intersection of Ridge Road and the exit driveway of McClure Elementary School.

Section 9. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby repeals Section 62-294 (4), Section 62-294 (5), and Section 62-296 (3) of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 10. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its final passage and publication as provided by law, after all the necessary signs and markings have been installed, and it is accordingly so ordained.

Section 11. Any person who violates any provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2000).
