

Charter Review Focus Areas





Terms

 The Commission is charged with evaluating current terms, adjustment to terms, and clarifying "service pause period".

Composition

 The Commission is charged with evaluating current council composition as it relates to the number of council members and district vs. at-large members.

Compensation

 The Commission is charged with evaluating current member/meeting compensation.

· Misc.

- The Commission is charged with evaluating misc. administrative items, and a possible automatic 10-year charter review process.
- The Commission is expected to be open to considering and evaluating other items as the charter review process takes place.



2024 Charter Committee Report - Terms

- The Committee is charged with evaluating current terms, adjustment to terms, and clarifying "service pause period".
- Based on comparable data, Commission discussion, and Commission preferencing polls the <u>Commission recommends</u> the following,
 - Maintain the current length of terms for City Council members and Mayor at 4 years per term, and
 - Maintain the current 1 year "pause" period for City Council members and the Mayor

- Based on comparable data, Commission discussion, and Commission preferencing polls the <u>Commission recommends</u> the following,
 - The City Council further analyze, study, and evaluate changes to the current Council composition.

2024 Charter Committee Report - Compensation

- The Commission was charged with evaluating current member/meeting compensation.
- Based on comparable data, Commission discussion, and Commission preferencing polls the <u>Commission recommends</u> adding the following Charter amendment proposition if a Charter amendment election is called,
 - Shall Section 16 of the City Charter be amended to provide for compensation of \$1,000 per month for the Mayor and \$750 per month for council members?
 - The Commission also recommends including a reasonable CPI adjustment on a periodic basis.

2024 Charter Committee Report – Misc.

- The Commission was charged with evaluating misc. administrative items, and a possible automatic 10-year charter review process and expected to be open to considering and evaluating other items as the charter review process takes place.
- Based on previously administered charter amendment proposals, historic charter review frequency, and Commission discussion the <u>Commission recommends</u> adding the following Charter amendment propositions if a Charter amendment election is called,
 - "Shall the City Charter be amended throughout to correct non-substantive errors such as misspellings, punctuation, grammar and sentence structure; conform notice and publication requirements to state law; and revise references to repealed or obsolete provisions of state law?"
 - "Shall the City Charter be amended to delete provisions, practices and policies which are no longer employed by the City of McKinney?"
