Boards & Commissions Policy

Governing Structure

- Can be advisory and/or decision-making
- Council Liaisons are non-members and non-voting

Eligibility

- Must be city residents **and** registered to vote
- Limited exceptions

Compliance

- Complete training and obey laws
- Open Government, Public Information, Ethics Code

Some memberships require relevant professional background

75% Attendance – same expectation for Regular members and Alternates

Term Limits: 2 or 3 consecutive appointments to the same board
