Re: Grant Amendment Request

On behalf of Habitat for Humanity of Collin County, I am writing to formally request an amendment to our current grant agreement #25-15.

As outlined in the original agreement, funds were allocated as follows: \$25,000 for demolition and \$15,000 for cleanup at 611 Bumpas Street; \$20,000 for Phase II of the Cotton Groves design; \$200,000 for the project at 1304 Garcia Street; and \$45,000 for the project at 305 Lively Hill, for a total award of \$305,000.

At this time, we are requesting approval to amend the agreement by reallocating the \$45,000 originally designated for 305 Lively Hill. We propose removing the 305 Lively Hill project from the agreement and redirecting those funds to support the project at 1304 Garcia Street.

This adjustment will allow us to more effectively utilize grant funds and maintain forward momentum on active and priority projects. All other components of the agreement will remain unchanged, and we remain committed to fulfilling the intent and impact of the original award.

We appreciate your consideration of this request and are happy to provide any additional information needed to support this amendment.
