## **Construction and Preservation Priority**

- Constructed: 1940
  - Brick residence on pier and beam
  - One-story, asymmetrical floor plan
  - Split-level entryway separating public and private spaces
- Style: Minimal Traditional or Transitional Ranch
- Priority: High


## **Character Defining Features**

- Asymmetrical facade
- Brick detailing under eaves
- Six-over-six windows
- Shutters
- Large exterior chimney on facade


