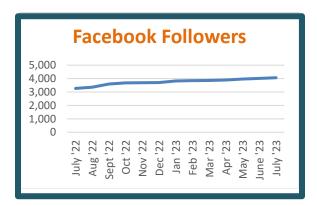


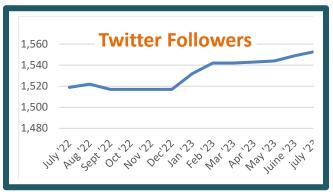

Social Media: Facebook and Twitter





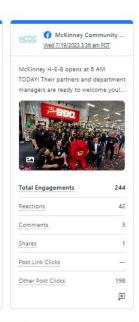

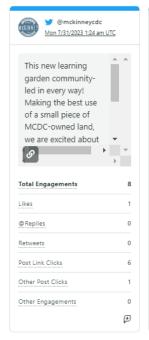

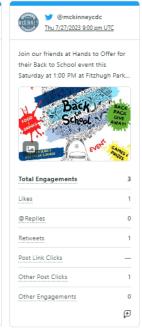






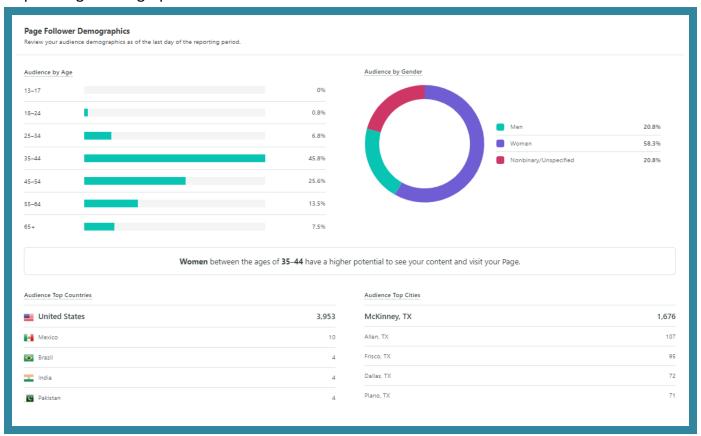


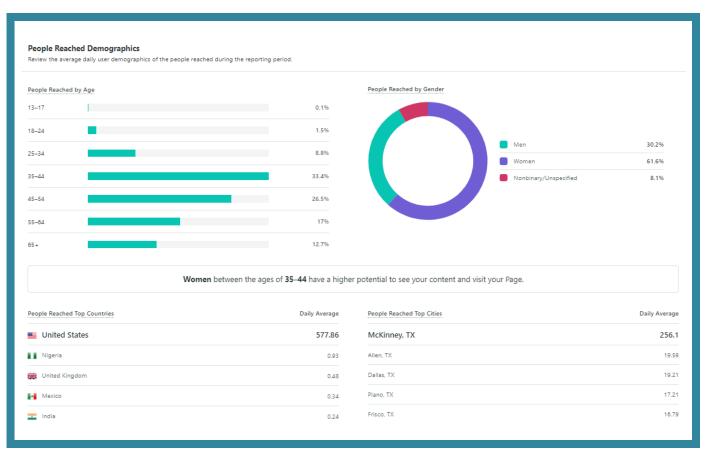




Facebook Demographics
