

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-06-\_\_\_\_(R)**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH COLLIN COUNTY FOR COLLIN COUNTY'S DULY ELECTED TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S TAX COLLECTOR AND PROVIDE FOR BILLING AND COLLECTION OF THE CITY'S AD VALOREM TAXES**

**WHEREAS,** The City acknowledges the need for the timely and accurate assessment and collection of the City's ad valorem taxes; and

**WHEREAS,** the City has the authority to require Collin County to act as tax assessor and collector for the City and the County has the authority to so act; and

**WHEREAS,** Collin County has served as the City's tax assessor and collector since 1998, as allowed by Chapter 6 of the Texas Tax Code; and

**WHEREAS,** consolidation of the tax assessment and collections functions of both the City and Collin County achieves cost savings for both entities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:**

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an interlocal cooperation agreement with Collin County for Collin County's duly elected Tax Assessor-Collector to act as tax assessor and collector for the City and to do and perform all acts necessary and proper to assess and collect the City's ad valorem taxes in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 6 of the Texas Tax Code.

Section 2. The City will pay to County a fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) per parcel or account within Collin County to bill and collect the City's ad valorem taxes for the first year of said agreement.
