A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$518,863 WITH DALLAS GARLAND & NORTHEASTERN RAILROAD INC. (DGNO), FOR THE RAILROAD CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS AT EAST VIRGINIA STREET REQUIRED FOR THE VIRGINIA STREET AND THROCKMORTON STREET INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING ALL NECESSARY CHANGE ORDERS UNDER SAID CONTRACT UP TO THE AGGREGATE CONTRACT AMOUNT, INCLUSIVE OF ANY CHANGE ORDERS, NOT TO EXCEED \$518,863

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, desires to make railroad improvements that are required for the Virginia Street and Throckmorton Street Infrastructure Improvements (Municipal Complex) Project (ST2235,); and
- WHEREAS, the City and Dallas Garland & Northeastern Railroad (DGNO) desire to enter into a Construction and Maintenance Agreement for the railroad crossing improvements at East Virginia Street required for the Virginia Street and Throckmorton Street Infrastructure Improvements (Municipal Complex) Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Construction and Maintenance Agreement in the amount of \$518,863 with Dallas Garland & Northeastern Railroad (DGNO) for the Railroad Crossing Improvements required for the Virginia Street and Throckmorton Street Infrastructure Improvements (Municipal Complex) Project and authorizing all necessary change orders under said contract up to the aggregate contract amount, inclusive of any change orders, not to exceed \$518,863.
- Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
