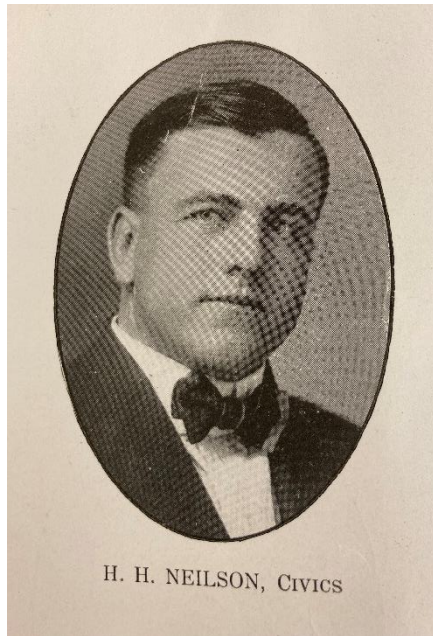
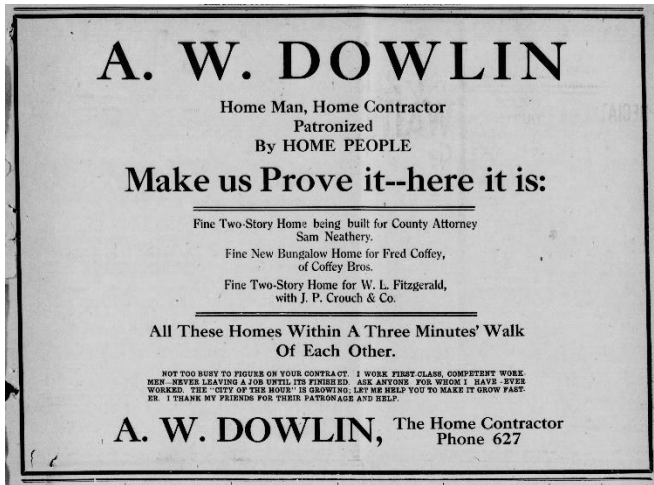


The Horace Neilson House 514 W. Hunt Street

- Constructed: c. 1917
 - Wood frame on pier and beam
 - Full width front porch with Tuscan columns
 - Near symmetrical façade with centrally located dormer
- Style: American Foursquare

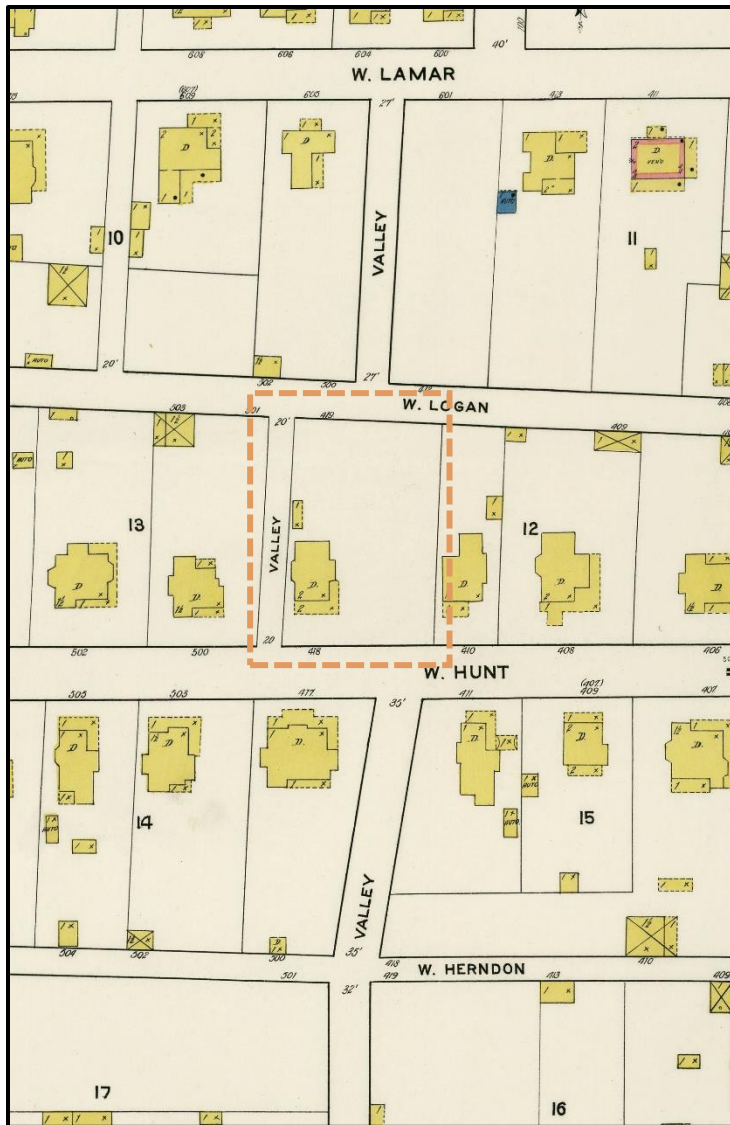




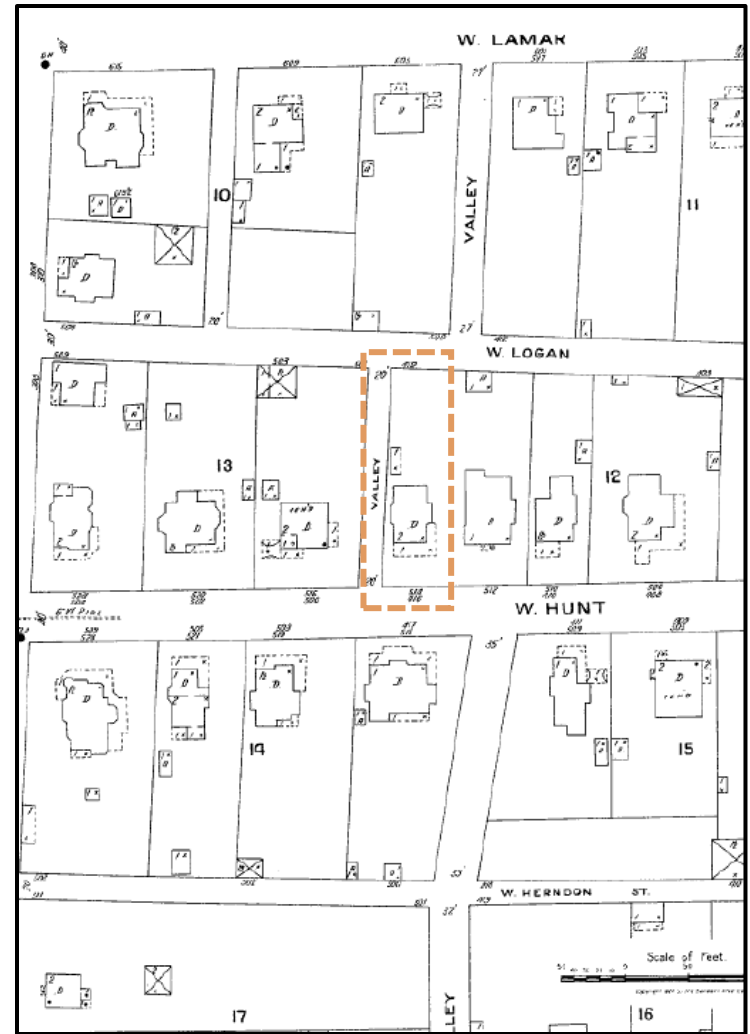
