

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-07-XXX (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR DISCRETIONARY FUNDING FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR PHASES II and III PLANNING AND DESIGN FOR THE EXTENSION OF TAXIWAY C AND ACCEPT FUNDING IF AWARDED.

WHEREAS, the Airport Improvement Program, Assistance Listing Number 20.116, provides grants for capital items related to the planning and development of public-use airports that are included in the National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems (NPIAS), such as McKinney National Airport.

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration has informed McKinney National Airport that discretionary funding will be made available for the design of Phases II and III of the Taxiway C Extension Project because it was deemed an important safety component to the commercial infrastructure on the east side of the airfield.

WHEREAS, the grant funding, if awarded, will be used for professional planning and design services for the extension of Taxiway C. These services include surveying, geotechnical analysis, design plans for Phases II and III, and bidding services for Phase II construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby authorizes the execution of all necessary documents for the submittal of a grant application to the Federal Aviation Administration under the Airport Improvement Program in the amount of \$2,736,000 with up to \$304,000 as required local match for a total project budget of \$3,040,000.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, authorizes the City Manager, or designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate necessary agreements to carry out the grant objectives described herein.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, designates the Director of Finance as the grant's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

Section 4. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, designates the Director of Airport as the programmatic lead. The programmatic lead is given the power to submit programmatic reports on behalf of the applicant agency.

Section 5. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, understands the City of McKinney, Texas, will be responsible for any cost overruns of the grant award.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
