
Select a dot for a property. A text box, called an attribute table, will appear. This contains information pertinent to the project you selected. Once you looked at all the properties with new items, click the "Planning Submittals Year-to-Date" button to see other plans and plats submitted this year.







You can also filter the map by plan type. Shown on this map are the site plans submitted as of September 2023.







Just like the "Planning Submittals" page, you can learn more about a specific non-residential building permit by clicking a dot on the map. An attribute table will appear with information about the permit (or permits) issued to that property in the last month. The color of the dot refers to the type of permit.






Non-Residential Building Permits Year-To-Date













You can see here that by clicking "5" in the table, the map closes in on the project site and displays the attribute table.
















Code Enforcement Cases Year-To-Date









27 Click arrow #2 to see code enforcement cases for the Year-To-Date.
