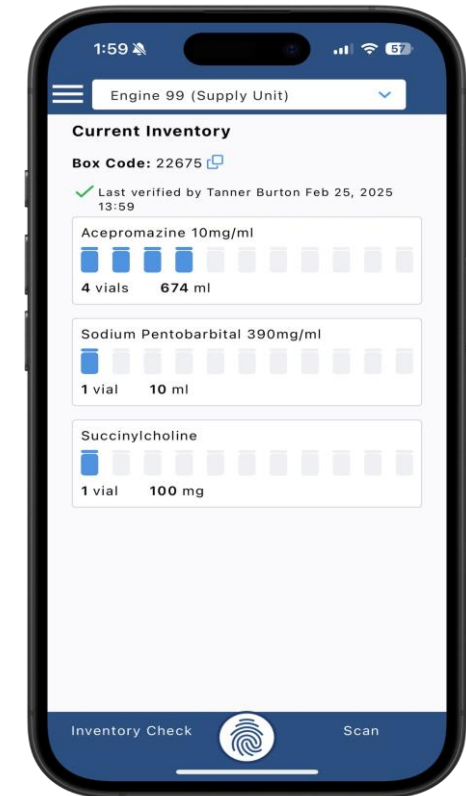

Transition to LogRX Digital Inventory System

Animal Services Has transitioned from maintaining paper-based inventory records to implement LogRX, a digital system designed to track the use of controlled substances.

This change specifically enhances documentation of sodium pentobarbital administered during the humane euthanasia of sick or injured animals.

By adopting LogRX, the department improves accuracy, accountability and compliance with all state and federal requirements while reducing the possibility of human related errors with manual recordkeeping.
