TUPPS Brewery Expansion Project - September 2022 Construction Update

SpawGlass [SG] mobilized on site February 28. They continue buyout of subcontractors/vendors for the project.

The Current Schedule indicates Substantial Completion staggered for the three building and site, now projected: Barrel Aging Building Nov 2, Site Nov 7, Brewery Dec 19, Tap Room Dec 23.

Below is a high-level recap of work progress and photos.

Sept 1 – Sept 3

Continuing erection of steel at Brewery Building, grading and compacting fire lane and EMT path, installing under ground plumbing for Tap Room







Sept 6 – Sept 9

Continue steel erection at Brewery Building, underground plumbing at Tap Room, digging approach at Green St.









Sept 12 – Sept 17

Underground rough-in for TapRoom, rebar, final grade & pour EMT Path/Fire Lane, continue steel at Brewery Building, demo fire lane panels to be replaced











Sept 19 - Sept 24

Backfill plumbing and grease trap; forming curbs and pour back Fire Lane Panels; Insulation at Brewery Building tin roof; backfill at Tap Room extension; install storm sewer between TapRoom and Barrel Aging















Sept 29 – 30

Erecting elevator shaft, digging trenches for connection of FDC for TapRoom, installing insulation and tin roof of Brewery Building
