The McKinney Urban Transit District Board met in regular session in the City Hall Council Chambers, 401 E. Virginia Street, McKinney, Texas on Tuesday October 06, 2025 at 4:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER

Board Chair Brian Loughmiller called the meeting to order at 4:04 p.m. upon determining a quorum was present.

25-3211 Transit Service Update

Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) Project Manager Ryan McCutchan presented key performance indicators for Collin County Transit.

Transit Administrator Jasmine Stillwell reviewed key findings of the study

including near, mid, and long-term goals for future transit service offerings in Collin County. Stillwell also identified next steps for transit staff after study review.

REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS

25-3213 Consider/Discuss/Act on an Amendment to the McKinney Urban Transit District (MUTD) Cost-Sharing Policy

Administrator Stillwell requested to update the current cost sharing policy for MUTD member cities to a distance-based formula based on miles travelled by riders.

Board unanimously approved the motion by Vice-Chair Feltus, seconded by board member Franklin.

25-3214 Consider/Discuss/Act on a Resolution Approving (1) Second Amendment and Exercise of Second Option Renewal of the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between the City of McKinney, Texas, and Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) Mobility Services, Local Government Corporation, (2) the related Second Amendment and Exercise of Second Option Term Renewal of the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for "GoPass" Subscription and License

Administrator Stillwell confirmed 2026 is the final option year and transit staff is preparing to bring options for service to the Board in early 2026.

Stillwell confirmed the current agreement runs through December 2026.

Board unanimously approved the motion by Board member Cloutier, seconded by Board member Cox.
