

RESOLUTION NO. 202X-XX-XXX (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FROM THE CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT PROGRAM FROM THE TEXAS HISTORICAL COMMISSION TO CREATE HISTORIC OVERLAY DISTRICT GUIDELINES AND ACCEPT FUNDING IF AWARDED.

WHEREAS, the Certified Local Government Grant Program, administered by the Texas Historical Commission, provides funding to develop and sustain an effective local preservation program critical to preserving local historic resources.

WHEREAS, the City of McKinney became a Certified Local Government in May 2025, cementing our city as a preservation forward community, allowing for us to be eligible in this grant opportunity.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney understands that protecting our historic local resources is critical to the vibrancy of our community.

WHEREAS, design guidelines for the historic overlay district provide consistent guidance to those looking to do alterations to historic buildings or new construction within the boundaries.

WHEREAS, the funding, if awarded, will be used to partner with a third-party consultant to do outreach related to and create design guidelines for the Historic Overlay District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby authorizes the execution of all necessary documents for the submittal of a grant application to the Texas Historical Commission under the Certified Local Government Grant in the amount of up to \$50,000 or 50% as required local match for a total project budget of \$100,000.
- Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, authorizes the City Manager, or designee, as the City’s authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate necessary agreements to carry out the grant objectives described herein.
- Section 3. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, understands the City of McKinney, Texas, will be responsible for any cost overruns of the grant award.
- Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
