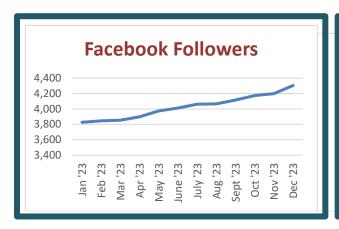

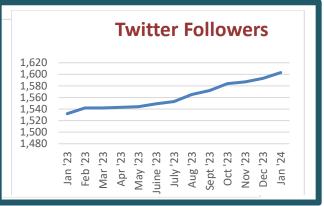


The number of website visitors using mobile devices was level for the month of January.

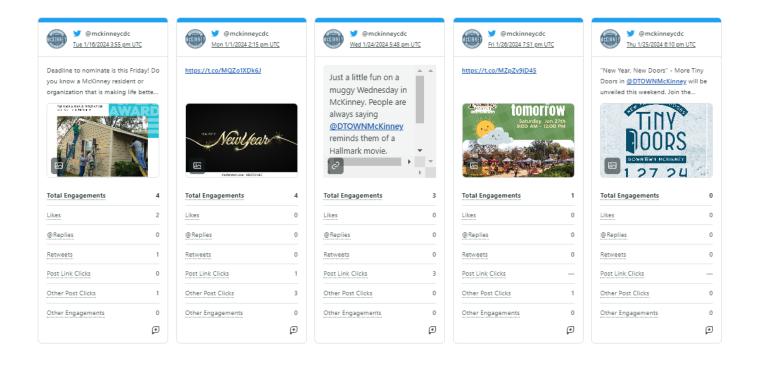
