Habitat for Humanity of Collin County is transforming a 2.75-acre strip of land into a 35-unit, affordable housing, town-home community.



Cotton Groves children, as well as neighboring communities enjoy a beautiful accessible playground


Cotton Groves is an affordable housing community located in McKinney developed by Habitat for Humanity, City of McKinney and MCDC.
