

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-11-XXX

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A CERTAIN BUDGET AMENDMENT PERTAINING TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 ANNUAL BUDGET TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR SMART TRUCK CAMERA TECHNOLOGY AND RECYCLING EDUCATION AND OUTREACH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF

WHEREAS, as required by the City Charter, the City Manager has prepared an amendment to certain appropriations and expenditures / expenses in the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Annual Budget and submitted same to the City Council for its approval and a true and correct copy is attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. Pursuant to the City Charter requirements of the City of McKinney, Texas, a Budget Amendment pertaining to the Fiscal Year 2025–2026 Annual Budget is hereby authorized and approved.
- Section 2. The budget shall be amended by appropriating \$578,000 of grant funds received from the Recycling Partnership in the Solid Waste Fund for the purchase of smart truck cameras and recycling education and outreach.
- Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its adoption and is so ordained.
