

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-05-XXX (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT, IF AWARDED, A SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM GRANT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR OVERTIME TRAFFIC SAFETY ENFORCEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Texas' Selective Traffic Enforcement Program ("STEP") is a federally funded law enforcement grant program run by the Traffic Safety Division of the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT"), with the intent of creating safer driving environments by reducing the number of vehicular crashes on local roadways; and

WHEREAS, the McKinney Police Department applied for a STEP grant for fiscal year 2024-2025, whereby said funds would be used to reimburse officer overtime expenses for traffic enforcement, with the City of McKinney ("City") required to provide matching funds for certain additional officer fringe benefits; and

WHEREAS, in the event of loss or misuse of the STEP grant funds, the City would be required to return any applicable funds to TxDOT in full pursuant to the terms of the STEP Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, desires to ratify the City Manager's application for, and if awarded, acceptance of a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) grant for fiscal year 2024-2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby approves this Resolution ratifying the City Manager's application for and acceptance of, if awarded, a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) grant for Fiscal Year 2025 from the Texas Department of Transportation for overtime traffic safety enforcement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of its passage, and it is so resolved.
