A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A NOMINATION FOR A STATEWIDE TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A HIKE AND BIKE TRAIL

- **WHEREAS,** the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, has determined the need for a hike and bike trail connection from Malvern Elementary School to Towne Lake; and,
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council approved the Parks Strategic Plan Hike and Bike Trail in June 2008;
- WHEREAS, the City desires to submit a nomination for a Statewide Transportation Enhancement Program reimbursement for the construction of a hike and bike trail connection from Malvern Elementary School to Towne Lake, and commits to the project's development, implementation, construction, maintenance, management and financing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit a nomination for a Statewide Transportation Enhancement Program reimbursement for the construction of a hike and bike trail from Malvern Elementary School to Towne Lake, and commits to the project's development, implementation, construction, maintenance, management and financing.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to provide funding for a 20% match of \$149,981 in addition to 100% of any cost overruns, should that occur.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
