A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR TECHNOLOGY GRANT FUNDING FOR DIGITAL SIGNAGE THROUGH THE CONOCO PHILLIPS CHARITABLE INVESTMENTS PROGRAM, THE MOODY FOUNDATION, AND THE ED RACHAL FOUNDATION AND ACCEPT FUNDING IF AWARDED.

WHEREAS, the ConocoPhillips Charitable Investments Program, the Moody Foundation, and the Ed Rachal Foundation provide grants on a competitive basis for a variety of entities and causes, including supporting the efforts of municipalities to provide and improve community and civic services.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney understands the importance of providing readily accessible public notices, which include but are not limited to public meetings, ordinances, financial information, contracts, and election information.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney supports efforts to improve the accessibility of public notices at City Hall, thereby improving public awareness, resident's civic participation, and community engagement.

WHEREAS, the grant funding, if awarded, will be used to purchase a digital touchscreen display and associated installation accessories for displaying public notices and citywide information in the City Hall lobby.

WHEREAS, the City seeks to improve the chances of receiving grant funding by applying to more than one grant program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby authorizes the execution of all necessary documents for the submittal of three grant applications to the ConocoPhillips Charitable Investments Program, the Moody Foundation, and the Ed Rachal Foundation in the amount of up to \$30,000.
- Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, authorizes the City Manager, or designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate necessary agreements to carry out the grant objectives described herein.
- Section 3. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, understands the City of McKinney, Texas, will be responsible for any cost overruns of the grant award.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
