

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-07-XXX (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE AIRPORT INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR THE MCKINNEY NATIONAL AIRPORT MASTER PLAN UPDATE (AI2501)

WHEREAS, The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act provided a total of \$15 billion between Fiscal Years 2022 and 2026 for the Airport Infrastructure Grant program, Assistance Listing Number 20.117, for airport-related construction and planning projects and allocated a total of \$1,362,000 to McKinney National Airport in Fiscal Years 2025 and 2026.

WHEREAS, the funding will be used to update both the Airport Master Plan and Airport Layout Plan at McKinney National Airport.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney understands that a current Airport Master Plan and Airport Layout Plan are required not only to guide safe and sustainable development of airport facilities and meet projected aviation demand, but also to maintain eligibility for federal funding.

WHEREAS, funding for the required 5% local match and additional project scope are currently appropriated in Project AI2501.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby authorizes the execution of all necessary documents for the submittal of a grant application to the Federal Aviation Administration under the Airport Infrastructure Grant for the City of McKinney's allotment of \$1,362,000, with a local contribution of \$524,980 to meet the both the 5% required match and to fund the remaining portion of the Airport Master Plan update.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, authorizes the City Manager, or designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate necessary agreements to carry out the grant objectives described herein.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, understands the City of McKinney, Texas, will be responsible for any cost overruns of the grant award.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
