

**RESOLUTION NO. 2012-01-\_\_\_ (R)**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FY 2012 LEAD-BASED PAINT HAZARD CONTROL PROGRAM GRANT, IF AWARDED. PREPARING A BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR CERTAIN EXPENDITURES RELATED TO THIS GRANT, AND DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE, AS THE OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CITY IN MATTERS RELATIVE TO THE PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of McKinney, recognizes the need for the application and authorizes the City Manager to apply for and receive an allocation of funds through the FY 2012 Lead Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program, if awarded, to Enhance City Efforts of Residential Environmental Safety and Reduce Lead-Based Paint Hazards of Eligible McKinney Housing within its Healthy Homes Initiative; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (hereafter referred to as "HUD") issued a Notice of Funding Availability (hereafter referred to as "NOFA") for the Lead Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program, based on funding approved by the Appropriations Act of 2012 (Public Law 112-55). HUD is authorized to approve allocations utilizing funding made available by Section 1011 of the Residential Lead Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992 (Title X of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1992, Public Law 102-550); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of McKinney agrees to terms and conditions of the NOFA and related program requirements established by HUD for the Lead Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program, including the requirement to certify by Resolution the approval and authorization of its City Manager to make grant submittal for said program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:**

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept, if awarded, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development FY 2012 Lead Based Paint Hazard Control Grant, and prepare a budget amendment for certain expenditures by the Community Services Department related to this grant, and handle all matters related to acceptance of said grant.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
