WHEREAS, Pam encourages readers to join the Army of Women and become one in a million, and learn how adequate hydration can help lower the risk of cancer.



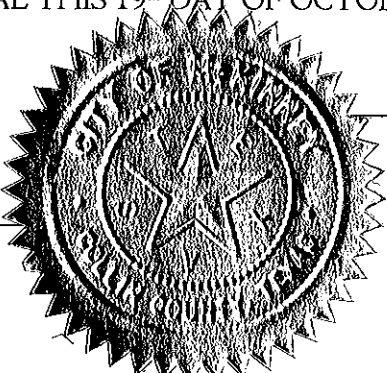
