

CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
CANVASSING THE RESULTS OF THE NOVEMBER 8, 2022
SPECIAL LOCAL OPTION ALCOHOL ELECTION

NOVEMBER 17, 2022

The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas met in special session in the City Hall Council Chambers, 222 N. Tennessee Street, McKinney, Texas, on Thursday, November 17, 2022, at 9:00 a.m.

The meeting was broadcast live on cable television Spectrum Channel 16 and AT&T U-Verse Channel 99; and online at <https://mckinney.legistar.com>; and the video recording of the meeting is available through the City of McKinney meeting archive.

Mayor George C. Fuller called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m. upon determining a quorum consisting of himself and the following Council Members were preset: Mayor Pro Tem Rainey Rogers, and Council Members Justin Beller, Charlie Philips, and Patrick Cloutier.

Council Members Geré Feltus and Rick Franklin were absent.

City of McKinney Staff Present: City Secretary Empress Drane, Communications & Marketing Creative Services Manager Michelle Feldker, McKinney Community Development Corporation (MCDC) Administrative & Marketing Coordinator Linda Jones, and McKinney Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) Senior Vice President Michael Talley

There were two (2) members of the public present in the audience.

Mayor Fuller called for Public Comments on Agenda Items, at which time no one requested to address the City Council.

Mayor Fuller called for the Special Agenda Item:

22-1076 Consider/Discuss/Act on an Ordinance Certifying the Election Results of the November 8, 2022 Special Local Option Alcohol Election

City Secretary Empress Drane stated the following election results of the November 8, 2022, City of McKinney Special Local Option Election as certified by the Collin County Election Administration:

The election ballot measure of whether to legalize the sale of all alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption was passed with a majority vote of forty-five thousand two hundred thirty-eight (45,238) for the measure representing 74.02% of all

ballots cast, and fifteen thousand eight hundred seventy-nine (15,879) votes against the measure representing 25.98% of all ballots cast.

Council Member Philips and Mayor Fuller jokingly recognized Mayor Pro Tem Rogers for leading the support for the election to which Mayor Pro Tem Rogers jokingly replied that he did not. Council Member Philips and Mayor Fuller went on the state that Mayor Pro Tem Rogers did not participate in the effort. Mayor Fuller stated the election will benefit the city by retaining potentially millions of sales tax dollars annually that generally are spent in neighboring cities.

Council unanimously approved the motion by Council Member Charlie Philips, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Rainey Rogers, to approve an Ordinance Certifying the Election Results of the November 8, 2022 Special Local Option Alcohol Election; Ordinance caption reads:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, CERTIFYING THE ELECTION RESULTS OF THE NOVEMBER 8, 2022 SPECIAL LOCAL OPTION ELECTION LEGALIZING THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR OFF-PREMISE CONSUMPTION; DECLARING THE RESULTS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE
