

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-07-____ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,033,280 WITH GARVER, LLC FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE RESIDENTIAL INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS (ANTHONY, GOUGH, NEILSON, MILLER & ENLOE) PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING ANY SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS UNDER SAID CONTRACT UP TO THE AGGREGATE CONTRACT AMOUNT, INCLUSIVE OF SAID SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS, OF \$1,140,000

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, recognizes the need for the Residential Infrastructure Improvements (Anthony, Gough, Neilson, Miller & Enloe) Project (CO2511); and

WHEREAS, the City has received a proposal from Garver, LLC to design the Residential Infrastructure Improvements (Anthony, Gough, Neilson, Miller, and Enloe) Project (CO2511).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract in the amount of \$1,033,280 as well as all required supplemental agreements thereto, with Garver, LLC for the design of the Residential Infrastructure Improvements (Anthony, Gough, Neilson, Miller, and Enloe) Project (CO2511) for a total aggregate contract amount, inclusive of any supplemental agreements, not to exceed \$1,140,000.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
