

- **WHEREAS,** in McKinney, Texas, we believe that children thrive in safe, stable, nurturing families, within their own communities it is necessary to build well-being systems that respond to crisis and are also intentional about supporting families before they are in crisis; and
- WHEREAS, sadly, child maltreatment is still a significant public health issue, and communities lacking accessible supports and resources can experience increased risk factors leading to child abuse and neglect. Despite its complexities, however, child maltreatment can be prevented; and
- **WHEREAS,** child abuse prevention occurs every day through the diligent work, tireless advocacy, and simple acts of kindness undertaken by families, friends, neighbors, houses of faith, advocacy groups, nonprofit organizations, schools, health-care providers, social workers, and government agencies to support children and families; and
- **WHEREAS,** child abuse prevention is not the duty of simply one community, agency, or system. Behind many families that overcome challenges, there is a strong community providing a way forward and helping to meet needs; and
- **WHEREAS,** each year the month of April is recognized as Child Abuse Prevention Month, and agencies such as the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services provides child abuse prevention resources to support children and their families where they live, work and play. It also encourages everyone to wear blue on *Go Blue Day*, which is Friday, April 5, in support of Child Abuse awareness and prevention.
