A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL **AGREEMENT** AND **MEMORANDUM** UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF PLANO, THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, THE CITY OF FRISCO, AND COLLIN COUNTY FOR THE APPLICATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE 2024 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT AWARD. DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AS THE OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY IN MATTERS RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need for the application for and acceptance of federal funds, allocated to the City of McKinney to assist the McKinney Police Department in enhancing public safety and reducing crime in the City of McKinney; and
- WHEREAS, the Justice Assistance Grant funds, as allocated by the U.S. Department of Justice, are to be shared between the City of Plano, the City of McKinney, the City of Frisco, and Collin County to enhance public safety and reduce crime in said communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to participate in the U.S. Department of Justice 2024 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant, and administer all matters related to acceptance of said grant award.
- Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into an Interlocal Agreement (Exhibit A) and Memorandum of Understanding (Exhibit B) with Collin County, the City of Frisco, and the City of Plano for the disbursement of the grant funds.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and it is so resolved.
