## SPECIAL EXCEPTION -

1. The size of our lot being 077 of an acre or 3,354 sq. ft. and one of the smallest, if not the smallest in the City per a recent meeting with the Appraisal District on 5/29/25 for which there are no comparisons.

2. The agreement by the Appraisal District to provide permanent relief at a reduction of 25% per year due to the installation of the sidewalk as a direct

result of the reduction of our lot size.

3. Last Year, the City absorbed over half of our front yard to install a 5ft wide ADA-compliant sidewalk which caused erosion of our yard into the street. We requested and twice met with City Engineer Alvin Maliakal & sub contractor Justin Wilson who agreed to the damages caused and made alterations to lower the slope in order to prevent further erosion.

4. In addition, and after having met with us twice, the City did not work to minimize the impact of the new sidewalk by placing it next to the curb like all of our surrounding neighbors, but instead installed the sidewalk in the middle of our yard making it now illegal for us to park in our driveway.

5. The City did not replace the sod they removed which encompassed most of our yard due to the very small lot size referenced above. They stated they would do so once all the sidewalks were completed on Virginia which was expected in August/September; the hottest months of the year in which the City institutes the most stringent watering restrictions. We expressed concerns over the timing, I was told it would be the homeowner's responsibility.

6. With the above in mind, I instead paid to install Saint Augustine and river rock the last week in May at a cost of \$2,440. At that time, we also paid an additional \$3,400 to install artificial turf to the remaining sodded portion of our backyard.

7. Despite all our efforts, portions of the Saint Augustine did not survive, even after replacing a portion of the turf last October.

## **VARIANCE** -

1. We have attempted sod three times in the past four years at a cost of just under \$5,000; twice of which was last year after the City removed our most of our front yard. This does not include the cost of watering.

2. We only considered articficial turf after having lost two of our 120+ year old trees in the storm that occurred the beginning of March at a removal cost of \$2,600. To take advantage of rainy season approaching and in an effort to replace our front yard tree with something drought tolerant, we moved

quickly to install a 30-gallon crepe myrtle at an additional cost of \$510.

3. Recognizing the increasing strain on water utilities, we then began to research alternatives to front yard landscape.

4. Noting the City's website and current Stage 2 Drought Contingency Plan minimizing watering to two days per week "due to excessive heat and drought conditions" to include no watering between 10AM - 6PM from April 1 to October 1 which is likely worsen as the summer progresses same as it has done the past few years.

5. We honestly did not realize that we had to seek City approval for front yard landscape seeing as we do not live in a homeowner's association.

6. After careful consideration of options and the increased moritoriams being implemented by municipalities due to the stress on water utilities, most recently neighboring Princeton, we elected to installed the highest grade artificial turf including an underlayment of peagravel and root barrier at a cost of \$3,280.

We are proud residents of McKinney, having worked very hard to pay our mortgage in full with continued investements to improve the value of our home and those of our surrounding neighbors. We ask that you consider the circumstances by which we came to install the artificial turf including the recent ruling in our favor by the Appraisal District and the long-term, proactive approach on an increasingly stressed water district.
