While the number of website visits remains nearly double over last year, May was a record high month for sessions, views and individual users likely related to the Promotional Grant application cycle. Top page visits in April were Home, Grants, and About Us. Connections via City of McKinney website remain high, and we also saw referrals from MEDC, SBG Hospitality, and GrantSeeker.

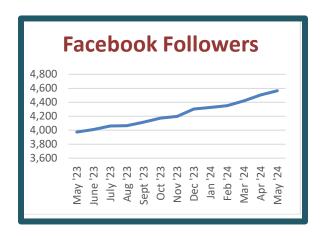


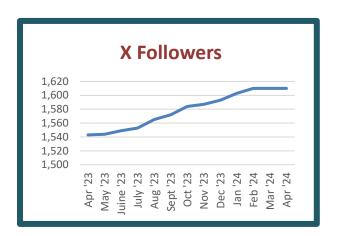

The number of website visitors using mobile devices was 30% higher for the month of May.

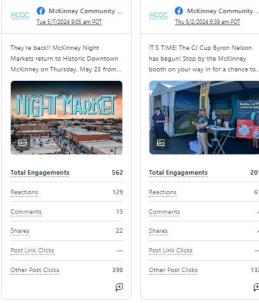

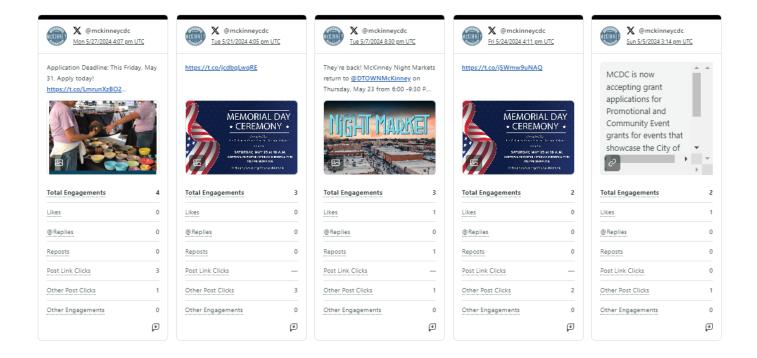
