

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-XX-XXX (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR AVAILABLE LAPSING FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION'S SECTION 5307 URBANIZED AREA FORMULA GRANT PROGRAM TO SUPPORT COLLIN COUNTY TRANSIT AND ACCEPT FUNDING IF AWARDED.

WHEREAS, the Section 5307 urbanized area formula grant program, administered by the Federal Transit Administration of the U.S. Department of Transportation, provides federal funding to urbanized areas for public transportation, including capital, planning, job access and reverse commute projects, and certain operating expenses.

WHEREAS, funding is allocated by a formula based on population, population density, and annual reports of transit service data.

WHEREAS, the funding supports mobility management and operating expenses for Collin County Transit, which provides subsidized, on-demand, share-ride transit services to eligible residents within the McKinney Urban Transit District service area cities, which are Celina, Lowry Crossing, McKinney, Melissa, Princeton, and Prosper. Eligible residents must be over the age of 18 and meet at least one of these criteria: senior (65+), disabled, or low income according to Federal Poverty Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby authorizes the execution of all necessary documents for the submittal of a grant application to the Federal Transit Administration under the Section 5307 Grant Program in the amount of \$7,361,706, with a required 50% match of \$3,680,853 for a total project budget of \$11,042,559.
- Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, authorizes the City Manager, or designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate necessary agreements to carry out the grant objectives described herein.
- Section 3. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, understands the City of McKinney, Texas, will be responsible for any cost overruns of the grant award.
- Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
