

By the Numbers



Total Circulation in August 2021 was only at 84% of circulation in July 2019, even with program attendance up. This is due, still, to our visitor count only reaching 84% of 2019 August totals. Public computer use in August 2021 (3,065 hours) was only 50% of use in August 2019 (6,088 hours).
