A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR ADDITIONAL CONSULTING ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE SH 5 UTILITY RELOCATIONS (POWER HOUSE STREET TO SPUR 399) PROJECT FOR AN INCREASE IN THE NOT TO EXCEED FEE FROM \$2,185,000 TO A TOTAL AGGREGATE CONTRACT AMOUNT, INCLUSIVE OF ANY ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS, NOT TO EXCEED \$2,385,000

WHEREAS, The City has received a proposal from Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. to provide additional consulting engineering services for the SH 5 Utility Relocations (Power House Street to Spur 399) Project (CIP Project WA1633 and WW1633); and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, recognizes the need for the additional consulting engineering services for the SH 5 Utility Relocations (Power House Street to Spur 399) Project (CIP Project WA1633 and WW1633).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a supplemental agreement with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. to provide additional consulting engineering services for the SH 5 Utility Relocations (Power House Street to Spur 399) Project (CIP Project WA1633 and WW1633) for an increase in the not to exceed fee from \$2,185,000 to a total aggregate contract amount, inclusive of any additional supplemental agreements, not to exceed \$2,385,000.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
