

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-07-____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS MODIFYING THE REDUCED SPEED SCHOOL ZONES AND TIMES FOR ROCK HILL HIGH SCHOOL TO INCLUDE JONES MIDDLE SCHOOL IN FRISCO, TEXAS; AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THE CAPTION OF THE ORDINANCE, EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF AND A PENALTY CLAUSE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends Section 62 – 225 of the Code of Ordinances, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-225 – Rock Hill High School – Zone Designated.

The Rock Hill High School zone shall be:

(1) On Northbound Coit Road beginning a point 355 feet south of Jackboro Lane and extending northward along Coit Road to a point 70 feet north of Prestwick Hollow Drive.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends Section 62 – 325.1 of the Code of Ordinances, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-325.1 Same – Speed.

The speed limit for the vehicles traveling the streets within the Rock Hill High School zone during the hours of 7:20 a.m. to 8:50 a.m. and 3:25 p.m. to 4:50 p.m., school days, shall be 20 miles per hour maximum.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its final passage and publication as provided by law, after all the necessary signs and markings have been installed, and it is accordingly so ordained.

Section 4. Any person who violates any provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2000).
