

- Semester Fees for Fall 2024 are paid by the volunteer singers in the chorus member fees are \$70 for most, but a \$10 per person discount applies for
 family members living in the same household. College students and those
 enrolled in trade school are discounted to \$35 per person. Several members
 are given financial aid due to financial circumstances.
- Fundraising takes place each semester utilizing North Texas Giving Day in the Fall and FanAngel in the Spring. Each fundraiser supports up to 20% of the event budget for each concert. Current and former members represent 30% of donors and close to 55% of total funds.
- Individual donors and business sponsors make up over 25% of income for the organization
- Grant income will vary this year an application to MCDC requests funds to cover the cost of advertising, while an application to McKinney Arts Commission has solicited to fund half of the event cost in a project grant at \$6300




















Event Survey
