## **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-10-XXX (R)**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE GUIDING PRINCIPLES FOR THE STRONGER TOGETHER INITIATIVE, WHICH SHALL INFLUENCE THE CITY'S EFFORTS TO ADDRESS THE MULTIFACETED ISSUES ASSOCIATED WITH HOMELESSNESS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas ("City Council") values the perspectives and concerns of all stakeholders in the City of McKinney ("City"), housed or unhoused, relating to the various issues associated with homelessness and desires to address said concerns through an all-inclusive and collaborative approach; and
- **WHEREAS**, it is the City's intent that the Stronger Together Initiative will provide such a unified and comprehensive approach towards addressing the symptoms and root causes of homelessness in the City; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and approved the guiding principles for the Stronger Together Initiative, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and finds and determines that such approach to addressing the multifaceted issues associated with homelessness is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of McKinney, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. The City Council hereby adopts the Stronger Together Guiding Principles, attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and it is so duly resolved.
