

**CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING**  
**CERTIFYING ELECTION RESULTS OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY SPECIAL**  
**CHARTER ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 5, 2024**

**NOVEMBER 15, 2024**

The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas met in special session in the City Hall Council Chambers, 222 N. Tennessee Street, McKinney, Texas, on Friday, November 15, 2023 at 12:00 p.m.

The meeting was broadcast live on cable television Spectrum Channel 16 and AT&T U-Verse Channel 99; and online at <https://mckinneytx.new.swagit.com/views/130>. A video recording of the meeting is available to members of the public through the City of McKinney meeting archive.

In accordance with Texas Election Code, Section 67.004(a), the special meeting convened with the required minimum number of two (2) Council members present.

Mayor George C. Fuller called the special meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. with a quorum consisting of himself and Council member Justin Beller being present.

Mayor Pro Tem Geré Feltus, and Council members Charlie Philips, Patrick Cloutier, Rick Franklin, and Michael Jones were not present.

These staff were present: City Attorney Mark Houser, Audio / Video Technician Joshua Arias, Deputy City Secretary Tenitrus Bethel Parchman, and City Secretary Empress Drane.

There were no members of the public in attendance.

Mayor Fuller called for Public Comments. There were none.

Mayor Fuller called for the Special Meeting agenda item:

**Proposition A** Shall Section 9 of the McKinney City Charter be amended to provide that mayor and city council members shall have term limits consisting of three (3) consecutive, four (4) year terms beginning with the 2025 election?

**Proposition B** Shall Section 16 of the McKinney City Charter be amended to provide for compensation of \$750 per month for newly-elected council members and \$1,000 per month for a newly-elected mayor beginning October 1, 2025?

**Proposition C** Shall the McKinney City Charter be amended throughout to correct non-substantive errors such as misspellings, punctuation, grammar and sentence structure and revise references to obsolete provisions of state law and harmonize conflicting sections and conform notice and publication requirements to state law?

**Proposition D** Shall the McKinney City Charter be amended to delete provisions, practices and policies which are no longer employed by the City of McKinney?
