AN AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION 2021-09-115 OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER APPROVE THE AMENDED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT, AND ANY ADDITIONALLY REQUIRED DOCUMENTS, WITH COLLIN COUNTY, FOR AN ADDITIONAL ALLOCATION OF \$3,000,000 ROUND 2 OF "CARES ACT" FUNDING TO THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY, THROUGH COLLIN COUNTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, recognizes the hardship that the COVID-19 virus has caused for McKinney residents and other residents of Collin County; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, has reviewed the Amended Interlocal Agreement between the City of McKinney and Collin County, Texas concerning the allocation of the CARES Act funding allotted to Collin County by the Department of the Treasury; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City Council has determined it to be in the best interests of the citizens to execute an extension to the Interlocal Agreement with Collin County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the Interlocal Agreement, and any additionally required documents, with Collin County, approving an additional allocation of \$3,000,000 of Round 2 "CARES Act" funding to the City of McKinney, from the Department of the Treasury, through Collin County.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
