- **WHEREAS,** Liv's talent and passion for tennis has been supported and influenced by the local tennis community in McKinney and across North Texas; and
- **WHEREAS,** Liv trained at the Courts of McKinney public tennis facility with Coach Matt Hanlin for two years, and continues to practice here regularly with various coaches; and
- **WHEREAS,** Liv is currently ranked No. 4 in the International Tennis Federation world junior rankings and is the No. 1 Class of 2024 high school recruit in the country; and
- **WHEREAS,** in 2022, Liv reached the girls Australian Open semifinals and girls French Open quarterfinals; and
- **WHEREAS,** in July 2022, Liv entered the Wimbledon girls' singles championship as the No. 1 seed; and
- WHEREAS, Liv dropped only one set enroute to the championship final; and
- **WHEREAS,** Liv won the 2022 Wimbledon girls' singles championship in straight sets, claiming her first junior Grand Slam crown; and
- **WHEREAS,** Liv is just the second American to win the title at the All England Club in the past 30 years, and only the 14th American girl to claim the trophy; and
- **WHEREAS,** Liv's accomplishments are a credit to her talent and determination and the support of her family, coaches; and
- **WHEREAS,** Liv is an inspiration to other young athletes and a shining source of pride for the city of McKinney.
