The Systems Department worked and updated certain aspects of the library. I'm very proud of the goals we've accomplished thus far.

- 1. ILL Worldcat login page updated with library branding.
- 2. Four touchscreen catalogs installed at JJGL. This created a more natural interaction without keyboards and mice devices. We did leave one keyboard at a sit-down catalog to aid handicap patrons.
- 3. All email notices from koha refreshed and branded with HTML. A modern look for patrons to view instead of the outdated text only notices.
- 4. Added a fourth children's gaming desktop. Very popular which increased game time for more children visiting the children's area.
- 5. Added two teen gaming desktops in the teen lounge area. These desktops give teens a different set of games for their age level.
- 6. Moved the Envisionware desktop from the public library area into our staff area. This allowed us to provide better patron seating to power outlets for charging devices.
- 7. The public desktops were changed to fully use our management program for restarts, sleep mode, and windows updates without staff interaction.
- 8. The City's Navline reports from the black and white printer in the checkout area moved to behind the staff door onto the Canon copier. The black and white printer repurposed for monochrome printing in the business center. It freed up the color printer to only do color prints now
- 9. The wireless APs, now provide monthly reporting of usage stats for us measure Wi-Fi levels at JJGL.
- 10. The robot contract finalized. The two robots will be in JJGL for further configuration by staff and interaction with the public.
