If you are aware of any such line, we MUST be notified immediately. We cannot be responsible for the puncture of improperly installed lines within three inches of the roof deck. •Satellite Dishes: During the reroof process it is sometimes necessary to remove the satellite dish from the roof. Ameritex will reinstall dish upon completion of roof, however Ameritex is not responsible for redirection of signal. •Driveways: When driveways are prepared & poured according to code, cracking is nonexistent. Driveways that have not been installed to withstand washout and heavy weight may crack when our disposal units and/or material contact them. Please let us know if you believe that there may be a problem of any kind pertaining to your driveway. Ameritex will make necessary arrangements and take appropriate action.
