## **Letter of Intent - Winsome Living at Virginia Parkway**

The proposed community, Winsome Living at Virginia Parkway (WVP McKinney), is a new construction development that will serve active adults age 55+. The 13.2106 +/- acre site is located at 5780 Virginia Parkway, McKinney, Texas 75070, north of Genesis Church. Currently, the site is zoned Agriculture (AG), and the request is for a Planned Development (PD) for active adults 55+. The proposed community will be offering one and two-bedroom floor plans.

The applicant is requesting a Planned Development district that is age-restricted for active adults 55+. The Planned Development ordinance will have an **age restriction of 55+ and a 2-story height restriction**. The proposed use will be Independent Living. Variances to this use include no on-site meal preparation, transportation services, or on-site health supervision or related care.

Bonner Carrington, the developer, requests the PD to meet the highly underserved need for senior housing in McKinney. According to the Housing Needs Assessment for the City of McKinney by Root Policy Research, "In McKinney, 11,064 households include at least one person 62 years or older, accounting for 21 percent of all households. Of those, 22 percent (2,475 households) have some housing need. Senior households may be less able to cope with increasing housing costs (rents for renters and property taxes for owners) as they are more likely to be living on a fixed retirement income. Most seniors desire to age in place but may need accessibility modifications as they age and may need additional support services to maintain their home and property properly." Rezoning this site to a PD restricted to active adults 55+ will allow McKinney residents to age in place while having access to appropriate resources and amenities.

Bonner Carrington is a Texas-based, vertically-integrated company that develops, owns, and operates communities throughout the state with over 20+ years of experience. Winsome Living at Virginia Parkway will be managed by Bonner Carrington Property Management (BCPM), the developer's in-house management company.
