### JOINT METING OF THE MCKINNEY CITY COUNCIL, MCKINNEY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (MCDC) & MCKINNEY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (MEDC)

#### APRIL 25, 2023

The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas met in joint session with the McKinney Community Development Corporation (MCDC) and McKinney Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) in the McKinney City Hall Council Chambers, located at 222 N. Tennessee Street, McKinney, Texas, on Tuesday, April 25, 2023, at 3:00 p.m.
