
The new Home for Hugs facility will provide a pool of skilled restaurant and hospitality employees, as well as a community awareness of inclusive hiring.















#### Economic Impact

A person with intellectual and developmental disabilities who is employed 20 hours per week in lieu of accessing state-funded programming, such as a day program, saves the state \$6,000 per person, per year.

The waitlist to receive state supported services is currently estimated at 15+ years.

There is the potential to save taxpayers up to \$600,000 per year for every 100 individuals that complete Hugs Training Academy or are employed by Hugs Cafe Inc.




