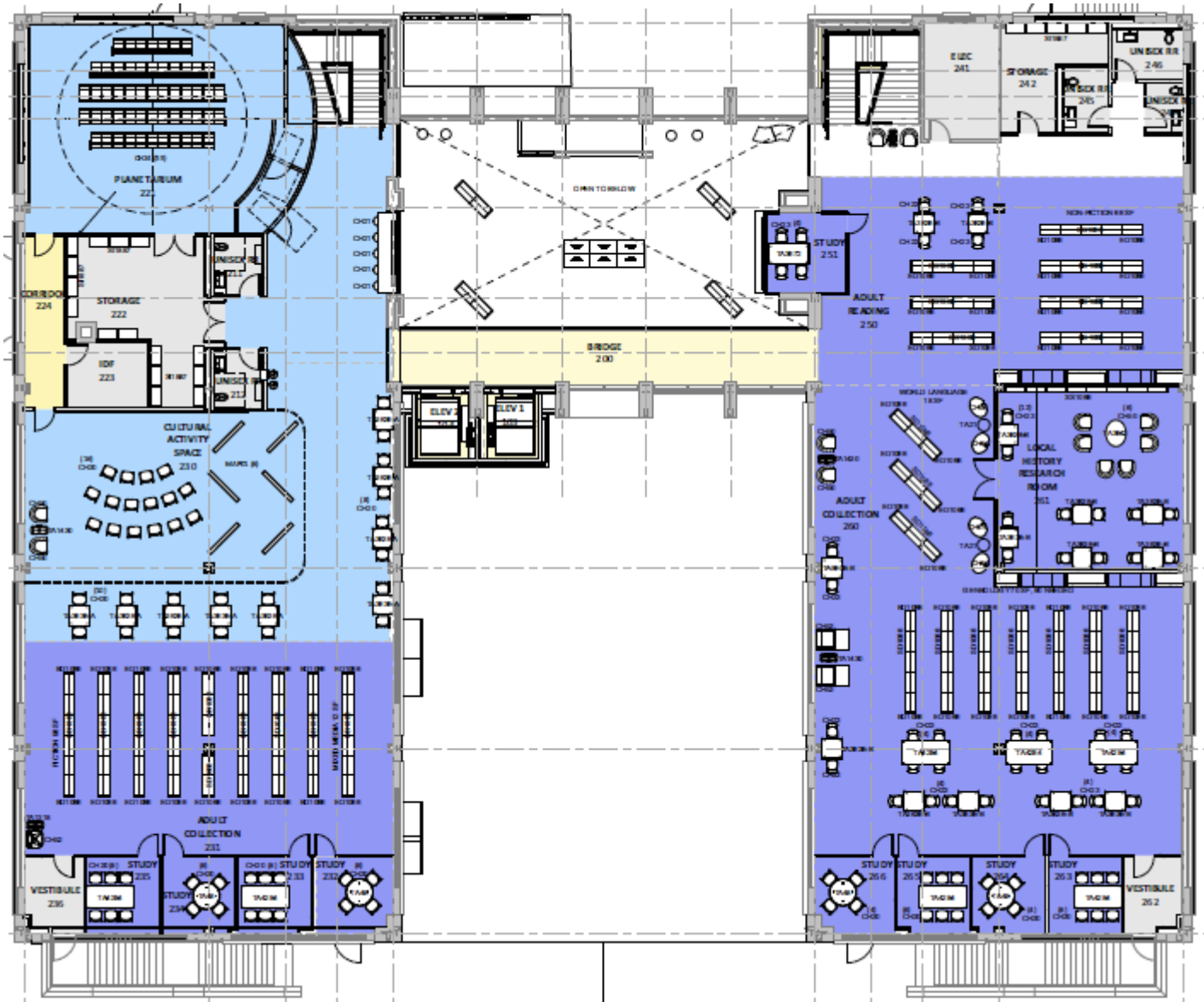


1st Floor Conceptual Renderings

Project Timeline

- July 2023: 720 Design contracted to provide initial concepts for renovations.
- May 2024: 720 Design contracted as designer and architect for the renovation project.
- October 2024: Crossland Construction Company selected as CMAR for the project.

- May 2025: Estimation for start of project construction.
