Re: Bid No. 20-48-CC Prestwyck Park

## Recommendation of Award

Dear Lisa,

A total of (7) bids were received for bid # 20-48-CC, Prestwyck Park at 2:00 pm on Thursday August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2020, with the apparent low bidder being MSB Constructors. However, after looking through their bid proposal we are not comfortable accepting their bid. On page 44 they have handwritten **\*estimates\*** and **\*subject to change as bids come in\***. The hand written notes lead us to believe the contractor expects to be able to negotiate a different number once their subcontractors are under contract which is not typical of a sealed bid process. The proposal also lists the total subcontractors as doing 75% of the work. The work to be done by the concrete subcontractor is listed as 28% of the project. This is a concern as the concrete numbers submitted are on average 50% lower than the other bids that were submitted. Lastly, they have no experience listed in their Project History that parallels a project like Prestwyck Park.

The second lowest responsible bidder was North Rock Construction. They have successfully built the City of McKinney/DCBA projects of Wilson Creek Trail, Comegys Trail, and the Fitzhugh Park Renovation. Given the above history, coupled with the fact that they are only subbing out 35% of their work (with 20% of that being the playground), it is my recommendation that North Rock Construction LLC be awarded bid # 20-48-CC, Prestwyck Park for the Base Bid plus all (8) Alternates total contract amount of \$2,633,249.81.
