

Electioneering

Regulations for city-owned voting locations

ELECTIONEERING is the posting, use, or distribution of political signs, literature, or material.

SIGNS can be posted 24 hours before until 24 hours after a voting period; max size 2ft x 2ft

Additional items:

- Electioneering must be at least 100 ft away
- Megaphones must be at least 1,000 ft away
- Unauthorized tents, booths, tables prohibited

Non-city voting locations may have different rules
